THE STAR MARKET REPORT

AUGUST 2020 BUILDING MATERIAL MARKET REFLECTION

Increased prices and longer lead times were the themes in the market place through August. Prices rose on all product lines, but the more challenging variable to manage was the increase in lead times. Some doubling almost overnight, sending purchasers scrambling to cover immediate needs. Price is becoming secondary in the market, with availability being the priority for most.

LUMBER/PLYWOOD/OSB

Lumber continued on its torrid pace, increasing at levels never seen before, averaging \$50/M- \$75/M USD per week over the month. In a market where supply was already very tight, it somehow got tighter as mills pushed order files into late September with early October shipments.

Plywood prices leveled off the first half of August but gained momentum in the lasted half of the month, as the availability between it and OSB pushed some buyers back to plywood. Order files moved into mid to late October. Much like lumber, OSB continued its blistering pace in August. Supply was extremely limited with mill order files stretching into October. Something to keep in mind is most OSB mills have maintenance shutdowns scheduled for October. What will the impact of those shutdowns mean to the marketplace? We will have to wait and see.

August has again taken us deep into uncharted waters. With the market continuing its upward momentum and order files stretching into October on most items, it's hard to believe anything will change in the short term. The question for all as we enter September is, how high will the prices go?



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ENGINEERED WOOD PRODUCTS

Pressure on EWP production schedules continues to grow heading into September, but we are seeing signs of a fall rush in the upcoming months.

As stable as pricing and supply has been the past few months on EWP, we are now seeing extended lead times and price increases coming on all products.

FINISHING PRODUCTS

The sales pace for finishing products was a bit slower for August, but we are seeing signs that it will start to pick up in September.

The supply pinch, which had been slowly working itself out, has again reared its head. Lead times have doubled on most items, with some reporting stock out as far as 10-12 weeks, causing some panic and scrambling. As predicted last month, we continue to see price increases coming on most SKU's.





FRAMING LUMBER COMPOSITE PRICE

AUGUST 28, 2020 LUMBER MARKET REPORT HIGHLIGHTS:

- The historic price run in framing lumber markets finished another week of strong increases.
- Some traders recoiled early in the week as lumber futures turned downward. But the board turned around amid the continued surge in cash, and the September contract posted limit-up gains
- The Random Lengths Framing Lumber Composite Price jumped to a new all-time high.

AUGUST 28, 2020 PANEL MARKET REPORT HIGHLIGHTS:

- Hurricane Laura exacerbated an already scarce supply situation in structural panel markets as the category 4 storm knocked out power to OSB mills in Texas and Louisiana.
- The Southern Pine plywood market was slow to react to further constraints in the storm's aftermath.
- Strong sales supported upward price momentum in western Fir plywood.
- Canadian plywood demand picked up, generating solid sales for producers.
